BACKGROUND ON THE PROMOTERS/ TEAM	The promoter / team are the individuals that will be working on the your project. Include here details on key team members only as space is limited. We are interested in information on previous experience working with refugees, but previous experience working with refugees is not a requirement.
OUTLINE OF PROPOSED PROJECT	Include here a summary of the what you will do should you be successful in your grant application. Space is limited so you have to be brief, but we are wanting to understand what you expect to achieve with the funding, and why your business and team are well placed to deliver the proposed project.
ACTIVITIES TO BE SUPPORTED	Include a brief description of the activities that the grant will support. Again space is limited but we want to get an idea of what you will be able to fund through the grant that you would not be able to do without the grant.
FUNDING REQUESTED	For Window 1 the funding requested must be in the range 500,000 BIRR to 1,000,000 BIRR. At this stage provide a total figure for the funding request. More details will be required for those applicants that are shortlisted and are asked to complete a full application. <u>Eligible costs</u> include personnel costs of the team members working on the project, costs of technical assistance such as short term consulting support, travel and accommodation costs (where necessary for the project), equipment and small scale infrastructure, office costs including telephone and internet. <u>Ineligible costs</u> include purchase of land or buildings, purchase of vehicles, entertainment and hospitality costs, items already funded through other programs or institutions, and finance costs or repayment of debts.
RESOURCES PROVIDED BY THE APPLICANT	There is a requirement that the applicant contributes to the project that is funded through the grant. At least 10% of the value of the grant should be contributed by the applicant, but this can be in the form of resources that the applicant provides and does not need to be a cash contribution. For example, if the applicant is providing premises or allocating staff time to the project that is not paid for by the grant, this should be explained here. We ask that you estimate a value for the resources that you are contributing so please also include an estimate in BIRR of the value of your planned contribution.
IMPACT OF THE PROJECT ON REFUGEES AND HOST COMMUNITIES	We need to understand how your proposed project will provide job opportunities for refugees and host communities, including an estimate of the number of refugees and host communities that will benefit.
